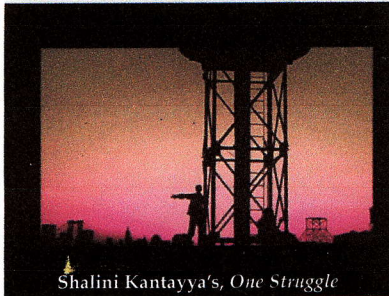


MFA Students Represent City College at CUNYarts



The film work of Shalini Kantayya and Gisela Sanders will be shown at CUNYarts, A gala evening of fiction, film, poetry and video created by MFA students from several CUNY campuses. Shalini's short film, *One Struggle*, is a fast-cutting hip-hop music video that captures the common experience of two

women, in rural India and urban America respectively, in their daily struggle to work and care for their families. Gisela's piece, *Lula Wakes*, explores how a woman expresses the effects of a traumatizing experience through dance. According to MFA Director Dave Davidson, "Having these two short films screen at CUNYarts is an opportunity for a large audience to experience some of the terrific non-thesis work that are our MFA students create. The maximum length for a CUNYarts film is 10 minutes and most of our thesis films are much longer."

CUNYarts will be held at the Elebash Recital Hall at the CUNY Graduate Center, 365 Fifth Avenue @ 34th Street on Friday, May 14th from 6:30-8:30pm. Admission is free. □
